| 9 | Government Code, the commissioner may issue an order to suspend, |
| 10 | for a period not longer than the duration of the declaration, |
| 11 | enforcement of the regulation of on-premises outdoor signs by |
| 12 | municipalities under Subchapter Z, Chapter 216, Local Government |
| 13 | Code, for municipalities located in counties within and adjacent to |
| 14 | the counties in the disaster area specified by the declaration, if |
| 15 | the commissioner finds that such a suspension would facilitate the |
| 16 | filing and processing of claims by persons affected by the |
| 17 | disaster. |
| 18 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives |
| 19 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as |
