## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to certificates of convenience and necessity.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 37.051, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (d), (e), and (f) to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) An electric utility or other person may not directly or
- 8 indirectly provide service to the public under a franchise or
- 9 permit unless the utility or other person first obtains from the
- 10 commission a certificate that states that the public convenience
- 11 and necessity requires or will require the installation, operation,
- 12 or extension of the service.
- 13 (d) A certificate may be granted to an electric utility or
- 14 other person under this section for a facility used as part of the
- 15 transmission system serving the ERCOT power region solely for the
- 16 transmission of electricity.
- 17 <u>(e) The commission may consider an application filed by a</u>
- 18 person not currently certificated as an electric utility for a
- 19 certificate of convenience and necessity to construct transmission
- 20 capacity that serves the ERCOT power region. Before granting a
- 21 certificate under this section, the commission must find, after
- 22 notice and hearing, that:
- 23 (1) the applicant has the technical ability, financial
- 24 ability, and sufficient resources in this state to own, operate,

- 1 and maintain reliable transmission facilities;
- 2 (2) the applicant has the resources and ability to
- 3 comply with commission rules, requirements of the independent
- 4 organization certified under Section 39.151 for the ERCOT power
- 5 region, and requirements of the National Electric Reliability
- 6 Council applicable to the provisions of transmission service; and
- 7 (3) for an application filed by a person that is not an
- 8 electric utility, granting the application will not adversely
- 9 affect wholesale transmission rates, as compared to the rates
- 10 projected to be charged if an existing electric utility were to
- 11 build the transmission facility.
- 12 <u>(f) The commission shall consider the requirements of</u>
- 13 Subsection (e) to have been met by an electric utility or other
- 14 person that:
- 15 (1) is selected by the commission as a transmission
- 16 provider under a plan adopted by the commission under Section
- 17 39.904 not later than September 1, 2009; and
- 18 (2) before the certificate is issued, provides to the
- 19 commission a detailed plan regarding the offices, personnel, and
- 20 other resources the electric utility or other person will have in
- 21 this state to ensure provision of continuous and adequate
- 22 transmission service.
- SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 37.053, Utilities Code,
- 24 is amended to read as follows:
- 25 (a) An electric utility or other person that wants to obtain
- 26 or amend a certificate must submit an application to the
- 27 commission.

- 1 SECTION 3. Sections 37.055, 37.057, and 37.151, Utilities
- 2 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 37.055. REQUEST FOR PRELIMINARY ORDER. (a) An
- 4 electric utility or other person that wants to exercise a right or
- 5 privilege under a franchise or permit that the utility or other
- 6 person anticipates obtaining but has not been granted may apply to
- 7 the commission for a preliminary order under this section.
- 8 (b) The commission may issue a preliminary order declaring
- 9 that the commission, on application and under commission rules,
- 10 will grant the requested certificate on terms the commission
- 11 designates, after the electric utility or other person obtains the
- 12 franchise or permit.
- 13 (c) The commission shall grant the certificate on
- 14 presentation of evidence satisfactory to the commission that the
- 15 electric utility or other person has obtained the franchise or
- 16 permit.
- 17 Sec. 37.057. DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION FOR NEW TRANSMISSION
- 18 FACILITY. The commission may grant a certificate for a new
- 19 transmission facility to a qualified applicant that meets the
- 20 <u>requirements of this subchapter.</u> The commission must approve or
- 21 deny an application for a certificate for a new transmission
- 22 facility not later than the first anniversary of the date the
- 23 application is filed. If the commission does not approve or deny
- 24 the application on or before that date, a party may seek a writ of
- 25 mandamus in a district court of Travis County to compel the
- 26 commission to decide on the application.
- Sec. 37.151. PROVISION OF SERVICE. Except as provided by

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- 1 this section, Section 37.152, and Section 37.153, a certificate
- 2 holder, other than those granted a certificate under Section
- $3 \frac{37.051(d)}{}$  shall:
- 4 (1) serve every consumer in the utility's certificated
- 5 area; and
- 6 (2) provide continuous and adequate service in that
- 7 area.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
