- 2 relating to certificates of convenience and necessity.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 37.051(a), 37.053(a), 37.055, 37.057,
- 5 and 37.151, Utilities Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 37.051. CERTIFICATE REQUIRED. (a) A person[electric
- 7 utility | may not directly or indirectly provide service to the
- 8 public under a franchise or permit unless the person[utility] first
- 9 obtains from the commission a certificate that states that the
- 10 public convenience and necessity requires or will require the
- 11 installation, operation, or extension of the service.
- 12 (d) A certificate may be granted to a person under this
- 13 subsection for a facility used solely for the transmission of
- 14 electricity.
- 15 Sec. 37.053. APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE. (a) A person
- 16 [An electric utility] that wants to obtain or amend a certificate
- 17 must submit an application to the commission.
- 18 Sec. 37.055. REQUEST FOR PRELIMINARY ORDER. (a) A person
- 19 [An electric utility] that wants to exercise a right or privilege
- 20 under a franchise or permit that the person [utility] anticipates
- 21 obtaining but has not been granted may apply to the commission for a
- 22 preliminary order under this section.
- 23 (b) The commission may issue a preliminary order declaring
- 24 that the commission, on application and under commission rules,

- 1 will grant the requested certificate on terms the commission
- 2 designates, after the $\underline{\text{person}}$ [electric utility] obtains the
- 3 franchise or permit.
- 4 (c) The commission shall grant the certificate on
- 5 presentation of evidence satisfactory to the commission that the
- 6 person [electric utility] has obtained the franchise or permit.
- 7 Sec. 37.057. DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION FOR NEW TRANSMISSION
- 8 FACILITY. The commission may grant a certificate for a new
- 9 transmission facility to any qualified applicant that meets the
- 10 requirements of this subchapter. The commission must approve or
- 11 deny an application for a certificate for a new transmission
- 12 facility not later than the first anniversary of the date the
- 13 application is filed. If the commission does not approve or deny
- 14 the application on or before that date, a party may seek a writ of
- 15 mandamus in a district court of Travis County to compel the
- 16 commission to decide on the application.
- 17 Sec. 37.151 PROVISION OF SERVICE.
- 18 Except as provided by this section, Section 37.152, and
- 19 Section 37.153, a certificate holder, other than those granted a
- 20 <u>certificate pursuant to Section 37.051(d)</u>, shall:
- 21 (1) serve every consumer in the utility's
- 22 certificated area; and
- 23 (2) provide continuous and adequate service
- in that area.
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
