- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 17(a), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) If, for good and sufficient reasons, a defendant desires
- 8 to change the defendant's [his] residence within the state, the
- 9 change may be effected by application to the defendant's
- 10 [supervising] supervision officer. A[, which] change of residence
- 11 <u>under this subsection is</u> [shall be] subject to the judge's consent
- 12 and subject to any conditions of community supervision the judge
- 13 imposes as a result of the change, in addition to any other
- 14 conditions imposed under this article [such regulations as the
- 15 judge may require in the absence of an officer in the locality to
- 16 which the defendant is transferred].
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 19, Article 42.12, Code of Criminal
- 18 Procedure, is amended by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 19 (i) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), in a misdemeanor case
- 20 in which the community supervision and corrections department
- 21 supervising a defendant changes as a result of a change in the
- 22 <u>defendant's residence</u>, the defendant shall pay any fee imposed on
- 23 the defendant under this section to the department currently
- 24 supervising the defendant.
