- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1602.051(a), Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The Advisory Board on Cosmetology consists of seven
- 7 [five] members appointed by the presiding officer of the
- 8 commission, with the commission's approval, as follows:
- 9 (1) one member who holds a license for a beauty shop
- 10 that is part of a chain of beauty shops;
- 11 (2) one member who holds a license for a beauty shop
- 12 that is not part of a chain of beauty shops;
- 13 (3) one member who holds a private beauty culture
- 14 school license; [and]
- 15 (4) two members who each hold an operator license;
- 16 (5) one member who is an educator from a public
- 17 secondary or postsecondary beauty culture school or program; and
- 18 <u>(6) one member who holds a specialty license or</u>
- 19 <u>certificate under this chapter</u>.
- 20 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 21 of this Act, the presiding officer of the Texas Commission of
- 22 Licensing and Regulation shall appoint the additional members to
- 23 the Advisory Board on Cosmetology as required by Section 1602.051,
- 24 Occupations Code, as amended by this Act.
