1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the membership of the Advisory Board on Cosmetology.
1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-12 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 1602.051, Occupations
1-13 Code, is amended to read as follows:
1-14 (a) The Advisory Board on Cosmetology consists of seven
1-15 [~~five~~] members appointed by the presiding officer of the
1-16 commission, with the commission's approval, as follows:
1-17 (1) one member who holds a license for a beauty shop
1-18 that is part of a chain of beauty shops;
1-19 (2) one member who holds a license for a beauty shop
1-20 that is not part of a chain of beauty shops;
1-21 (3) one member who holds a private beauty culture
1-22 school license; [~~and~~]
1-23 (4) two members who each hold an operator license;
1-24 (5) one member who represents a licensed public
1-25 secondary or postsecondary beauty culture school or program; and
1-26 (6) one public member.
1-27 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
1-28 of this Act, the presiding officer of the Texas Commission of
1-29 Licensing and Regulation shall appoint the additional members to
1-30 the Advisory Board on Cosmetology as required by Section 1602.051,
1-31 Occupations Code, as amended by this Act.
1-32 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
