A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to a requirement that a full TEXAS grant be awarded to each

3 eligible applicant in an academic year.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 56.307, Education Code, is amended by

6 adding Subsection (m) to read as follows:

7 (m) Before the beginning of each academic year, the coordinating board shall determine and certify to each eligible 8 9 institution the total amount of money necessary for the institution to award, without reference to any factor that could affect a grant 10 award such as financial need, the full amount of a TEXAS grant to 11 each eligible applicant who enrolls at the institution during that 12 academic year. Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, 13 14 after the coordinating board certifies the total amount necessary to award those grants with respect to an eligible institution, the 15 16 institution shall award the full amount of the TEXAS grant to each eligible applicant who enrolls at the institution. Notwithstanding 17 any other law, an eligible institution that fails to satisfy the 18 requirements of this subsection may not spend any of the 19 institution's unobligated institutional funds or any money 20 appropriated to the institution for instruction or operations in 21 the academic year for which the coordinating board certified the 22 23 total amount necessary to award grants as required by this

subsection. An eligible institution may elect to reduce the amount

- 1 of a grant awarded to any eligible applicant only as permitted by
- 2 Subsections (i-1) and (j).
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 4 beginning with TEXAS grants awarded for the 2010 fall semester.
- 5 Grants awarded for a semester or term before the 2010 fall semester
- 6 are covered by the applicable law in effect immediately before the
- 7 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 8 effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
