- 9  $\underline{\text{three-quarters of one}}$  [ $\underline{\text{two}}$ ] percent of the total  $\underline{\text{covered}}$  [ $\underline{\text{taxable}}$ ]
- 10 wages for the four calendar quarters ending the preceding June 30;
- 11 and
- 12 (2) the floor of the compensation fund is equal to the
- 13 greater of:
- 14 (A) \$400 million; or
- 15 (B) one percent of the total taxable wages for
- 16 the four calendar quarters ending the preceding June 30.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
