- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 434.017(c) and (e), Government Code, as
- 5 redesignated and amended by Chapter 1418 (H.B. 3107), Acts of the
- 6 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, are amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (c) Money in the fund may be appropriated to the Texas
- 9 Veterans Commission to:
- 10 (1) enhance or improve veterans' assistance programs,
- 11 including veterans' representation and counseling; [and]
- 12 (2) make grants to [local communities to] address
- 13 veterans' needs; and
- 14 (3) administer the fund.
- 15 (e) To carry out any purpose of this chapter, the Texas
- 16 Veterans Commission may accept a gift, grant, devise, bequest of
- 17 money, security, service, or property, including money raised or a
- 18 service provided by a volunteer or volunteer group, to promote the
- 19 work of the commission. The commission may participate in the
- 20 establishment and operation of an affiliated nonprofit
- 21 organization that is established for the purpose of raising money
- 22 for or providing services or other benefits to the commission [The
- 23 comptroller may solicit and accept gifts and grants to the fund. A
- 24 gift or grant to the fund may be appropriated in the same manner as

- 1 other money in the fund, subject to any limitation or requirement
- 2 placed on the gift or grant by the donor or granting entity].
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
