A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to audio recordings of certain grievance proceedings or 3 meetings by school district employees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 11.171, Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

Sec. 11.171. SCHOOL DISTRICT GRIEVANCE POLICY. 7 (a) Α 8 school district grievance policy must permit a school district employee to report a grievance against a supervisor that alleges 9 10 the supervisor's violation of the law in the workplace or the supervisor's unlawful harassment of the employee to a supervisor 11 12 other than the supervisor against whom the employee intends to report the grievance. 13

(b) A school district grievance policy must permit a 14 15 grievant to make an audio recording of any meeting or proceeding at which the substance of a grievance that complies with the policy is 16 investigated or discussed, provided that the grievant gives three 17 working days notice of the intention to make the audio recording to 18 the person considering the grievance. The implementation of this 19 subsection may not result in a delay of any timelines provided by 20 the grievance policy and does not require the district to provide 21 22 equipment for the grievant to make the recording.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
