A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the Texas Rural Investment Fund.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Agriculture Code, is amended by
5	adding Section 12.046 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 12.046. TEXAS RURAL INVESTMENT FUND. (a) In this
7	section:
8	(1) "Fund" means the Texas Rural Investment Fund.
9	(2) "Rural community" means a municipality with a
10	population of less than 50,000 or a county with a population of less
11	than 200,000.
12	(b) The fund is a dedicated account in the general revenue
13	<pre>fund and consists of:</pre>
14	(1) appropriations of money to the fund by the
15	legislature;
16	(2) gifts, grants, including federal grants, and other
17	donations received for the fund; and
18	(3) interest earned on the investment of money in the
19	fund.
20	(c) The fund may be used by the department only to:
21	(1) pay for grants or loans to public or private

stimulate one or more of the following:

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entities for projects in rural communities that have strong local

support, provide positive return on the state's investment, and

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1	(A) local entrepreneurship;
2	(B) job creation or retention;
3	(C) new capital investment;
4	(D) strategic economic development planning;
5	(E) individual economic and community
6	development leadership training;
7	(F) housing development; or
8	(G) innovative workforce education; and
9	(2) administer the grant and loan program under this
10	section.
11	(d) In awarding a grant or loan of money from the fund for a
12	<pre>project, the department shall consider:</pre>
13	(1) the project's effect on job creation and wages;
14	(2) the financial strength of the applicant;
15	(3) the applicant's business history;
16	(4) an analysis of the relevant business sector;
17	(5) whether there is public or private sector
18	financial support for the project; and
19	(6) whether there is local support for the project.
20	(e) The fund is exempt from the application of Sections
21	403.095 and 404.071, Government Code.
22	(f) The department may accept grants, gifts, or donations
23	from any source that are made for the purposes of this section.
24	Money received under this subsection shall be deposited in the
25	fund.
26	(g) The department shall adopt rules to administer this
27	section.

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1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
