1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the designation of Farm-to-Market Road 1015 in Hidalgo
1-9 County as the Bill Summers International Boulevard.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to recognize
1-12 Bill Summers for his unselfish sacrifices in developing a close
1-13 relationship between the Rio Grande Valley and the State of
1-14 Tamaulipas, United Mexican States.

1-15 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subchapter B, Chapter 225,
1-16 Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 225.077 to read
1-17 as follows:

1-18 Sec. 225.077. BILL SUMMERS INTERNATIONAL BOULEVARD.

1-19 (a) Farm-to-Market Road 1015 between U.S. Highway 83 and the
1-20 Progreso International Bridge is designated as the Bill Summers
1-21 International Boulevard.

1-22 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall
1-23 design and construct memorial markers indicating the highway
1-24 number, the designation as the Bill Summers International
1-25 Boulevard, and any other appropriate information.

1-26 (c) The department shall erect a marker at each end of the
1-27 boulevard and at appropriate intermediate sites along the
1-28 boulevard.

1-29 (d) The requirement that a recognized individual be
1-30 deceased under Section 225.001(c) does not apply to this section.

1-31 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
