- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 621.508, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 621.508. AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE FOR OPERATING VEHICLE
- 8 OVER MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE AXLE WEIGHT. It is an affirmative defense to
- 9 prosecution of, or an action under Subchapter F for, the offense of
- 10 operating a vehicle with a gross [single axle] weight [or tandem
- 11 axle weight] heavier than the [axle] weight authorized by law that
- 12 at the time of the offense the vehicle:
- 13 (1) had a gross [single axle] weight [or tandem axle
- 14 weight] that was not heavier than the [axle] weight authorized by
- 15 law plus 12 percent;
- 16 (2) was loaded with timber, pulp wood, wood chips, or
- 17 cotton, livestock, or other agricultural products that are:
- 18 (A) in their natural state; and
- 19 (B) being transported from the place of
- 20 production to the place of first marketing or first processing; and
- 21 (3) was not being operated on a portion of the national
- 22 system of interstate and defense highways.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
