- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 4002, Insurance Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 4002.008 to read as follows:
- 8 REPORT. (a) This section applies only to insurance agent license

Sec. 4002.008. STANDARDS FOR EXAMINATION PASS RATES; ANNUAL

- 9 examinations for limited and single lines licenses, including agent
- 10 licenses issued under:

- 11 (1) Subchapter C, Chapter 4051; and
- 12 (2) Subchapters C and G, Chapter 4054.
- 13 (b) The commissioner or, at the commissioner's discretion,
- 14 the testing service, shall review a license examination subject to
- 15 this section if, during any 12-month period beginning on September
- 16 1 of a year that examination exhibits an overall pass rate of less
- 17 than 70 percent for first-time examinees.
- 18 <u>(c) The department shall compile an annual report based on</u>
- 19 the review required under Subsection (b). The report must be based
- 20 on demographic data. The report must indicate whether there was any
- 21 disparity in the pass rate based on race, gender, or national origin
- 22 and, if there was such a disparity, the causes of the disparity.
- 23 (d) A report that indicates a disparity under Subsection (c)
- 24 must describe what, if any, corrective action will be taken to

- 1 remedy the identified disparity.
- 2 (e) The commissioner by rule may establish procedures as
- 3 necessary to:
- 4 (1) collect demographic information necessary to
- 5 implement this section; and
- 6 (2) ensure that a review required under Subsection (b)
- 7 <u>is conducted</u>, and the resulting report is prepared, impartially.
- 8 <u>(f) The commissioner shall deliver the report prepared</u>
- 9 under Subsection (c) to the governor, the lieutenant governor, and
- 10 the speaker of the house of representatives not later than December
- 11 1 of each year.
- 12 SECTION 2. (a) The first 12-month period for which a
- 13 license examination review may be required under Section
- 14 4002.008(b), Insurance Code, as added by this Act, begins September
- 15 1, 2009.
- 16 (b) The commissioner of insurance shall deliver the initial
- 17 report required under Section 4002.008, Insurance Code, as added by
- 18 this Act, not later than December 1, 2010.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
