(c) The department shall give each applicant the option of 24

taking the parts [traffic law and highway sign part] of the 1 examination under Subsections (b)(1)(B), (C), and (D) in writing in 2 addition to or instead of through a mechanical, electronic, or 3 other testing method. If the applicant takes that part of the 4 5 examination in writing in addition to another testing method, the applicant is considered to have passed that part of the examination 6 if the applicant passes either version of the examination. 7 The 8 department shall inform each person taking the examination of the person's rights under this subsection. 9

10 SECTION 2. A driver's license examination administered by 11 the Department of Public Safety is not required to include a 12 question required by Section 521.161(b)(1)(D), Transportation 13 Code, as added by this Act, if the examination is administered 14 before February 1, 2010.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
