A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the closure or modification of certain man-made passes
3	between the Gulf of Mexico and inland bays by the commissioner of
4	the General Land Office.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 33, Natural Resources
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 33.613 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 33.613. CLOSURE OR MODIFICATION OF CERTAIN MAN-MADE
9	PASSES. (a) Notwithstanding Sections 66.204 and 81.103, Parks and
10	Wildlife Code, the commissioner may undertake the closure or
11	modification of a man-made pass or its environs between the Gulf of
12	Mexico and an inland bay if:
13	(1) the commissioner determines that the pass causes
14	or contributes to significant erosion of the shoreline of the
15	adjacent beach;
16	(2) the pass is not a public navigational channel
17	constructed or maintained by the federal government; and
18	(3) the land office receives legislative
19	appropriations or other funding for that purpose.
20	(b) If the closing of a man-made pass under this section
21	results in a loss of public recreational opportunities, the
22	commissioner shall develop, in consultation with the Parks and
23	Wildlife Department and the county and, if applicable, the
24	municipality in which the pass is located, and approve a plan to

- 1 mitigate the loss. In developing the plan, the commissioner is
- 2 strongly encouraged to assess the feasibility of installing fishing
- 3 piers, boat ramps, and other facilities that provide public
- 4 recreational opportunities. The plan must be presented to the
- 5 public for comment before the commissioner approves it.
- 6 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2011, the commissioner
- 7 of the General Land Office shall submit to the 82nd Legislature a
- 8 report on the progress of the commissioner in implementing any
- 9 mitigation plan approved under Subsection (b), Section 33.613,
- 10 Natural Resources Code, as added by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act does not make an appropriation. This
- 12 Act takes effect only if a specific appropriation for the
- 13 implementation of the Act is provided in a general appropriations
- 14 act of the 81st Legislature.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
