13	(2) changing a traffic lane;
14	(3) improving a road bed; or
15	(4) improving a drainage ditch located on a
16	right-of-way.
17	(b) The authority of the Texas Transportation Commission
18	under this section is limited to a line of a telephone or telegraph
19	corporation that is located on a state highway and not in the
20	corporate limits of a municipality.
21	(c) The authority of a commissioners court of a county under
22	this section is limited to a line of a telephone or telegraph
23	corporation that is located on a county road and not in the
24	corporate limits of a municipality.

1 SECTION 2. Section 181.090, Utilities Code, as added by 2 this Act, applies only to a project to widen a right-of-way, change 3 a traffic lane, improve a road bed, or improve a drainage ditch on a 4 right-of-way that is begun on or after the effective date of this 5 Act.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
