- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 159.034, Local
- 7 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The commissioners court may require the report to be
- 9 filed with the clerk of the commissioners court, the county
- 10 auditor, or any other county officer. However, the commissioners
- 11 court may require the report to be filed with the county clerk or
- 12 other elected county officer only if the county clerk or elected
- 13 county officer consents to the imposition of that duty. [$\frac{The}{T}$
- 14 commissioners court may contract with the secretary of state for
- 15 the filing of reports under this subchapter.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
