1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 159.034, Local
1-13 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-14 (a) The commissioners court may require the report to be
1-15 filed with the clerk of the commissioners court, the county
1-16 auditor, or any other county officer. However, the commissioners
1-17 court may require the report to be filed with the county clerk or
1-18 other elected county officer only if the county clerk or elected
1-19 county officer consents to the imposition of that duty. [The
1-20 ~~commissioners court may contract with the secretary of state for~~
1-21 ~~the filing of reports under this subchapter.~~]

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-26 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
