1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the compensation of a member of the board of directors
1-9 of the Bexar-Medina-Atascosa Counties Water Control and
1-10 Improvement District No. 1.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 9007, Special District
1-13 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 9007.055 to read as
1-14 follows:

1-15 Sec. 9007.055. COMPENSATION. Notwithstanding Section
1-16 49.060(a), Water Code, a director is not entitled to receive a fee
1-17 of more than \$150 a month for performing the duties of a director.

1-18 SECTION 2. Section 9007.055, Special District Local Laws
1-19 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to the compensation of a
1-20 member of the board of directors of the Bexar-Medina-Atascosa
1-21 Counties Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 for
1-22 performing the duties of a director on or after the effective date
1-23 of this Act. Compensation for performing the duties of a director
1-24 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
1-25 effect when the duties were performed, and the former law is
1-26 continued in effect for that purpose.

1-27 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
1-28 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
1-29 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
1-30 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
1-31 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
1-32 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
1-33 Government Code.

1-34 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
1-35 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
1-36 Environmental Quality.

1-37 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
1-38 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
1-39 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
1-40 representatives within the required time.

1-41 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
1-42 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
1-43 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
1-44 and accomplished.

1-45 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-46 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-47 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-48 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-49 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
