4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 21.054, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
7	(d) Continuing education requirements for a superintendent
8	or a principal of an elementary, middle, or junior high school must
9	include at least two hours of classroom education training every
10	five years regarding coordinated health programs required under
11	Sections 38.013 and 38.014. The board, in conjunction with the
12	Texas Department of Agriculture, the Department of State Health
13	Services, and the agency, shall develop or approve a curriculum
14	that may be used for purposes of this subsection. The curriculum
15	must provide instruction regarding:
16	(1) health education;
17	(2) physical education and physical activity;
18	(3) nutrition services; and
19	(4) parental involvement.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
