21	(3) prescribe the manner of selecting party officers,
22	convention delegates, convention alternates, and convention

- 1 officers, convention delegates, convention alternates, and
- 2 convention officials throughout the state on the basis of
- 3 population, party strength, or both, within the appropriate

- 5 (5) provide for periodic publication and publicizing

- 7 (6) prescribe the manner of adopting party rules and
- 8 amendments to the rules.
- 9 (b) A political party adopting rules under this section
- 10 shall review rules adopted under subsection (a)(3) no less than
- 11 once every two years at the state convention.
