11	board on or after the date the license expired, the person may renew

13	(1) fulfilling continuing education requirements as
14	set by the board; and
15	(2) paying the renewal fees for each year in which the
16	license has been expired.
17	(e) A person whose license has been expired for <u>four years</u>
18	[one year] or more may not renew the license. The person may obtain
19	a new license by complying with the requirements and procedures for
20	obtaining an original license.
21	SECTION 2. Section 503.354, Occupations Code, as amended by
22	this Act, applies only to a licensed professional counselor license
23	renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A license
24	renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
