4	SECTION 1. Title 4, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
5	amended by adding Chapter 100H to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 100H. LIABILITY FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
7	Sec. 100H.001. LIABILITY. A defendant is liable, as
8	provided by this chapter, to a claimant for damages arising from
9	conduct towards the claimant that is an offense under Section
10	22.01, Penal Code, and punishable under Section 22.01(b)(2), Penal
11	<u>Code.</u>
12	Sec. 100H.002. DAMAGES. A claimant who prevails in an
13	action under this section may recover:
14	(1) the claimant's actual damages, including damages
15	for mental anguish even if an injury other than mental anguish is
16	not shown;
17	(2) subject to Chapter 41, exemplary damages; and
18	(3) court costs and reasonable attorney's fees.
19	Sec. 100H.003. EQUITABLE RELIEF. In an action for damages
20	under this section, the court may award the claimant equitable
21	relief as the court considers proper.
22	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
23	to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
24	this Act. A cause of action that accrued before the effective date

1 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the 2 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for 3 that purpose.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
