1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to information and assistance provided by the chief
1-11 appraiser to emergency management authorities.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 6, Tax Code, is amended by
1-14 adding Section 6.053 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 6.053. ASSISTANCE TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
1-16 AUTHORITIES. The chief appraiser shall, if requested by the
1-17 emergency management authorities of a federal, state, or local
1-18 government agency, provide information and assistance pertinent to
1-19 disaster mitigation or recovery, including assisting in the
1-20 estimation of damage from an actual or potential disaster event.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
