| 8 | FOR CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICTS. (a) Notwithstanding any other |
| 9 | provision of this chapter, a school district is not required to |
| 10 | satisfy any wealth per student limitation prescribed by Section |
| 11 | 41.002 and is not required to take any action under Section 41.003 |
| 12 | to achieve the equalized wealth level if the district is located at |
| 13 | least partially in a county with a population of 1.5 million or more |
| 14 | and: |
| 15 | (1) 20 percent or more of the students in |
| 16 | prekindergarten through fifth grade in the district are classified |
| 17 | as students of limited English proficiency, as defined by Section |
| 18 | <u>29.052;</u> |
| 19 | (2) 50 percent or more of the total students in the |
| 20 | district are economically disadvantaged, as determined by the |
| 21 | commissioner, and have family incomes below the federal poverty |

(3) 65 percent or more of the students in

- 1 <u>economically disadvantaged</u>, as determined by the commissioner;
- 2 (4) the district has a student mobility rate of 25
- 3 percent or higher, as determined by the commissioner; and
- 4 (5) 75 percent or more of the total students in the
- 5 district are minority students, as determined by the commissioner.
- 6 (b) A school district that establishes eligibility for the
- 7 exception provided by this section is entitled to the exception for
- 8 a period of four consecutive school years. After that period, the
- 9 district remains eligible for the exception until the student
- 10 population of the district results in district percentages
- 11 regarding at least two of the criteria specified in Subsection (a)
- 12 that are more than five percentage points below the percentages
- 13 <u>specified in Subsection (a) for those criteria.</u>
- 14 (c) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 15 administer this section.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
