## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the confidentiality of certain travel vouchers
  3 submitted by certain peace officers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 660, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 660.2035 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 660.2035. TRAVEL VOUCHERS OF CERTAIN OFFICERS. (a) A
- 8 travel voucher submitted by a peace officer for travel authorized
- 9 and required to provide personal protection for an elected official
- 10 or a member of an elected official's family is confidential and not
- 11 <u>subject to disclosure under Chapter 552.</u>

- 12 (b) Upon request, the governmental body employing a peace
- 13 officer who submits a voucher described in subsection (a) shall
- 14 summarize the amounts claimed and the corresponding products or
- 15 services purchased as described in such voucher(s).
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to vouchers not disclosed before the effective date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
