3	Sec. 236.003. MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE PREVAILS OVER COUNTY
4	ORDER. If an order adopted under this chapter conflicts with an
5	ordinance of a municipality, the municipal ordinance prevails
6	within the municipality's jurisdiction to the extent of the
7	conflict.
8	Sec. 236.004. EXISTING COUNTY AUTHORITY UNAFFECTED. The
9	authority granted by this chapter does not affect the authority of
10	the commissioners court to adopt an order or ordinance under other
11	law.
12	Sec. 236.005. INJUNCTION. The county, in a suit brought by
13	the county attorney or other prosecuting attorney representing the
14	county in the district court, is entitled to appropriate injunctive
15	relief to prevent the violation or threatened violation of an order
16	adopted under this chapter from continuing or occurring.
17	Sec. 236.006. PENALTY. A person commits an offense if the
18	person violates a restriction or prohibition imposed by an order
19	adopted under this chapter. An offense under this section is a
20	Class C misdemeanor.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
