## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to retirement qualifications for appellate judges.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 839.102, Government Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (f) and adding Subsection (g) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (f) The service retirement annuity of a member qualifying
- 8 for retirement under Section 839.101(a)(4) is the applicable state
- 9 salary under Subsection (a) multiplied by a percentage amount that
- 10 is the sum of 50 percent plus the product of 2.3 percent multiplied
- 11 by the number of years of <u>prior service credit under Subsection (g)</u>
- 12 <u>and</u> subsequent service credit the member accrues under Section
- 13 840.1027. After including any increase under Subsection (b), the
- 14 service retirement annuity under this subsection may not be an
- 15 amount that is greater than 90 percent of the applicable salary
- 16 under Subsection (a).
- 17 (g) For purposes of Subsection (f), a member's prior service
- 18 credit is the amount of service credit that the member earned in the
- 19 retirement system prior to serving on an appellate court that is in
- 20 excess of the amount of service credit that the member requires to
- 21 be eligible to retire and receive a service retirement annuity
- 22 under Section 839.101(a)(4).
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to a person who retires on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 The change in law does not apply to a person who retired before the
- 2 effective date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act does not make an appropriation. A
- 4 provision in this Act that creates a new governmental program,
- 5 creates a new entitlement, or imposes a new duty on a governmental
- 6 entity is not mandatory during a fiscal period for which the
- 7 legislature has not made a specific appropriation to implement the
- 8 provision.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
