A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation of an additional judicial district
3	composed of Harris County and the preference given by the district
4	court to domestic violence cases.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 24.60020 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 24.60020. 476TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (HARRIS COUNTY). (a)
9	The 476th Judicial District is composed of Harris County.
10	(b) Subject to any jurisdictional limitations, the 476th
11	District Court shall give preference to:
12	(1) domestic violence cases, including cases
13	involving:
14	(A) dating violence, as defined by Section
15	71.0021, Family Code;
16	(B) family violence, as defined by Section
17	71.004, Family Code;
18	(C) abuse or neglect, as defined by Section
19	261.001, Family Code, of a child; or
20	(D) elder abuse;
21	(2) any matter in which pleadings are filed
22	concurrently with an application for a protective order under Title
23	4, Family Code, that involves both parties;
24	(3) any matter involving minor children if one parent

- 1 is alleged to have caused the death of another parent and there is a
- 2 history of domestic violence in the parents' relationship; and
- 3 (4) cases in which:
- 4 (A) a court has made an affirmative finding of
- 5 family violence involving both parties; or
- 6 (B) a protective order has been issued under
- 7 <u>Title 4, Family Code, involving both parties.</u>
- 8 (c) The 476th District Court shall:
- 9 (1) provide timely and efficient access to emergency
- 10 protective orders and other court remedies for persons the court
- 11 determines are victims of domestic violence;
- 12 (2) integrate victims' services for persons the court
- 13 determines are victims of domestic violence who have a case before
- 14 the court; and
- 15 (3) promote an informed and consistent court response
- 16 to domestic violence cases to lessen the number of misdemeanors,
- 17 felonies, and fatalities related to domestic violence in Harris
- 18 County.
- 19 (d) The clerk for the 476th District Court shall create a
- 20 form to transfer a domestic violence case that the 476th District
- 21 Court is required to give preference to under this section to the
- 22 476th District Court.
- 23 SECTION 2. The 476th Judicial District is created on the
- 24 effective date of this Act.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
