- relating to orders of nondisclosure for the records of children 2 convicted of certain offenses punishable by fine only. 3
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 411.081, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (f-1) to read as follows:
- (f-1) In this subsection, "child" has the meaning assigned 7
- by Section 51.02, Family Code. Notwithstanding any other provision 8
- 9 of this subchapter, on conviction of a child for a misdemeanor
- offense punishable by fine only that does not constitute conduct 10
- indicating a need for supervision under Section 51.03, Family Code, 11
- the convicting court shall immediately issue an order prohibiting 12
- criminal justice agencies from disclosing to the public criminal 13
- 14 history record information related to the offense. A criminal
- justice agency may disclose criminal history record information 15
- 16 that is the subject of the order only to other criminal justice
- agencies for criminal justice or regulatory licensing purposes, to 17
- an agency or entity listed in Subsection (i), or to the person who 18

- SECTION 4. Section 552.142(a), Government Code, is amended

- SECTION 5. Section 552.1425(a), Government Code, is amended

- 19 disseminate information with respect to which the entity has

- 25 SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act applies to a

- 2 SECTION 7. Notwithstanding Section 6 of this Act, a child,
- 3 as that term is defined by Section 51.02, Family Code, who is
- 4 convicted of a misdemeanor offense punishable by fine only that
- 5 does not constitute conduct indicating a need for supervision under
- 6 Section 51.03, Family Code, before the effective date of this Act
- 7 may petition the court for an order of nondisclosure, and the court
- 8 shall issue the order under Section 411.081(f-1), Government Code,
- 9 as added by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
