16	office of a local governmental entity to use the commission's
17	software and other commission resources to file disclosure reports
18	of contributions and expenditures required by Title 15, Election
19	Code.
20	Sec. 571.202. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
21	(1) "Local governmental entity" and "local government
22	officer" have the meanings assigned by Section 176.001, Local
23	Government Code.

- 3 Sec. 571.203. USE OF COMMISSION SOFTWARE AND RESOURCES.
- 4 (a) To fulfill the purpose of this subchapter and to facilitate

- 7 the commission may allow the use of commission software and
- 8 <u>resources by:</u>
- 9 <u>(1) a local governmental entity;</u>
