2	relating to certain reporting duties of the attorney general.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 247.050(a), Health and Safety Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(a) The board shall adopt procedures to monitor the status
7	of unlicensed assisted living facilities. As part of these
8	procedures, the department shall[+
9	$[\frac{(1)}{(1)}]$ maintain a registry of all reported unlicensed
10	assisted living facilities for the purpose of periodic follow-up by
11	the field staff in each region[; and
12	(2) prepare a quarterly report that shows the number
13	of:
14	[(A) complaints relating to unlicensed assisted
15	living facilities that are received;
16	[(B) complaints that are investigated;
17	[(C) unsubstantiated complaints;
18	[(D) substantiated complaints; and
19	[(E) cases referred to the attorney general].
20	SECTION 2. The following sections of the Health and Safety
21	Code are repealed:
22	(1) Section 242.005; and
23	(2) Sections 247.050(b) and (c).
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
