- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 16.131, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:

- 7 Sec. 16.131. AUTHORIZED PROJECTS. The board may use the
- 8 state participation account of the development fund:
- 9 $\underline{\text{(1)}}$ to encourage optimum regional development of
- 10 projects including the design, acquisition, lease, construction,
- 11 reconstruction, development, or enlargement in whole or part of:
- (A) $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ reservoirs and storm water retention
- 13 basins for water supply, flood protection, and groundwater
- 14 recharge;
- (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ facilities for the transmission and
- 16 treatment of water; and
- (C) $[\frac{(3)}{(3)}]$ treatment works as defined by Section
- 18 17.001 of this code; and
- 19 (2) to acquire water rights or existing public water
- 20 systems to encourage optimum regional development of desalination
- 21 projects.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 16.135, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 23 follows:
- Sec. 16.135. BOARD FINDINGS. Before the board may acquire a

- 1 facility or interest in a facility, the board shall find
- 2 affirmatively that:
- 3 (1) it is reasonable to expect that the state will
- 4 recover its investment in the facility;
- 5 (2) the cost of the facility exceeds the current
- 6 financing capabilities of the area involved, and the optimum
- 7 regional development of the facility cannot be reasonably financed
- 8 by local interests without state participation;
- 9 (3) the public interest will be served by acquisition
- 10 of the facility; [and]
- 11 (4) the facility to be constructed or reconstructed
- 12 contemplates the optimum regional development which is reasonably
- 13 required under all existing circumstances of the site; and
- 14 (5) if appropriate, the facility to be acquired
- 15 encourages optimum regional development of a desalination project.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
