- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1403.002(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) As provided by <u>Sections</u> [Section] 49-1 and 49-q, Article
- 9 III, Texas Constitution, the authority shall, in accordance with
- 10 requests from the office of the governor:
- 11 (1) issue general obligation bonds and notes in an
- 12 aggregate amount not to exceed \$350 million [\$175 million], as
- 13 authorized by the office of the governor under Subsection (b); and
- 14 (2) as directed by the Texas Department of
- 15 Transportation, distribute the proceeds from the sale of the bonds
- 16 and notes to counties to provide financial assistance for colonia
- 17 access roadway projects to serve border colonias.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the date on which the
- 19 constitutional amendment proposed by the 81st Legislature, Regular
- 20 Session, 2009, authorizing the issuance of additional state general
- 21 obligation bonds and notes to provide financial assistance to
- 22 counties for roadway projects to serve border colonias, takes
- 23 effect. If that amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act
- 24 has no effect.
