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	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to providing housing assistance to rural communities and
3	small municipalities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2306.0521(b), Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(b) This section does not apply to <u>:</u>
8	(1) the manufactured housing division; or
9	(2) the division for rural community and small
10	municipality housing initiatives established by Section 2306.302.
11	SECTION 2. Section 2306.253, Government Code, is amended by
12	adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to read as follows:
13	(a-1) In addition to the education program implemented
14	under Subsection (a), the department shall develop and implement a
15	homebuyer education program designed to provide information and
16	counseling to individuals and families of low income in rural
17	communities and small municipalities. The education program must
18	address topics relating to:
19	(1) the home buying process;
20	(2) financial literacy;
21	(3) foreclosure remediation; and
22	(4) other programs determined by the department as
23	necessary to increase home ownership by individuals and families of
24	<u>low income.</u>

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1	(a-2) The department may require any person who receives
2	mortgage-based financial assistance from the department to
3	complete the homebuyer education program established by Subsection
4	<u>(a-1).</u>
5	SECTION 3. Chapter 2306, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter N to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER N. RURAL COMMUNITY AND SMALL MUNICIPALITY
8	HOUSING INITIATIVES
9	Sec. 2306.301. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "division"
10	means the division established by Section 2306.302 to support rural
11	community and small municipality housing initiatives.
12	Sec. 2306.302. ESTABLISHMENT OF DIVISION. (a) The
13	department shall establish a division to support rural community
14	and small municipality housing initiatives.
15	(b) The department by rule shall define:
16	(1) a small municipality; and
17	(2) a rural community.
18	Sec. 2306.303. REGIONAL HOUSING DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATIONS.
19	(a) The division shall establish regional nonprofit housing
20	development organizations that serve rural communities and small
21	municipalities in accordance with the purposes of this subchapter.
22	(b) To implement this section, the department may use any
23	money available to the department for the purpose, including
24	legislative appropriations and gifts, grants, and donations.
25	(c) The division may use the services of the Texas State
26	Affordable Housing Corporation when necessary to accomplish the
27	purposes of this section.

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1	Sec. 2306.304. TRAINING. The division annually shall
2	provide to elected officials, community organizations, nonprofit
3	organizations, and private developers a training course that
4	addresses housing programs and techniques that increase housing
5	opportunities in rural communities and small municipalities. The
6	division shall provide the course at an appropriate location
7	selected by the division and shall make the course available online
8	in real time.
9	Sec. 2306.305. RURAL GRANTS ADMINISTRATOR. (a) The
10	director shall designate a rural grants administrator within the
11	division established by Section 2306.302.
12	(b) The rural grants administrator shall:
13	(1) oversee and coordinate division initiatives that
14	are directed toward specific rural communities or small
15	municipalities; and
16	(2) provide information to the director and the board
17	regarding the impact of proposed department programs, rules, and
18	initiatives on housing opportunities in rural communities and small
19	municipalities.
20	Sec. 2306.306. HOUSING DEVELOPMENT PLANNING ASSISTANCE. On
21	the request of the governing body of a municipality or county, the
22	division shall assign a department employee or independent
23	contractor to assist the municipality or county in:
24	(1) developing comprehensive housing plans for rural
25	communities and small municipalities in that county;
26	(2) supporting housing development initiatives in
27	those communities and municipalities; and

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1	(3) identifying financial resources available for
2	those plans and initiatives.
3	Sec. 2306.307. RURAL COMMUNITY AND SMALL MUNICIPALITY
4	HOUSING DEVELOPMENT PILOT PROJECTS. Notwithstanding other program
5	rules and procedures of the department, the division may establish
6	pilot projects to test and develop new approaches to providing
7	housing in rural communities and small municipalities for:
8	(1) individuals and families of low income;
9	(2) individuals and families of very low income; or
10	(3) agricultural workers.
11	Sec. 2306.308. AGRICULTURAL WORKER HOUSING INITIATIVE. (a)
12	The division shall fund housing initiatives that serve agricultural
13	workers, including:
14	(1) new housing initiatives;
15	(2) housing rehabilitation initiatives; or
16	(3) tenant-based rental assistance.
17	(b) The division may designate a housing initiative for
18	agricultural workers as a pilot project authorized under Section
19	2306.307.
20	(c) The division shall coordinate with other appropriate
21	divisions of the department to:
22	(1) document agricultural worker housing needs;
23	(2) determine whether a housing need documented by the
24	department is critical; and
25	(3) develop initiatives to address those housing
26	needs.
27	(d) The division may use any available funds to implement

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1 this section, including legislative appropriations and gifts, 2 grants, and donations.

Sec. 2306.309. RURAL LAND BANK DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM. (a) 3 The department may adopt a rural land bank demonstration program, 4 5 or may enter into a memorandum of understanding requiring the Texas State Affordable Housing Corporation to adopt a rural land bank 6 demonstration program, in which the officer charged with selling 7 8 real property ordered sold pursuant to foreclosure of a tax lien may sell certain eligible real property by private sale for purposes of 9 affordable housing development as provided by department rule. 10

11 (b) The department may adopt any rules necessary for the 12 purposes of the program, including a rule to establish or approve a 13 land bank for the purpose of acquiring, holding, and transferring 14 unimproved real property under this section.

15 SECTION 4. (a) Not later than December 1, 2009, the Texas 16 Department of Housing and Community Affairs shall implement the 17 homebuyer education program required by Section 2306.253(a-1), 18 Government Code, as added by this Act.

(b) Not later than October 1, 2009, the Texas Department of
Housing and Community Affairs shall adopt the rules required by
Subchapter N, Chapter 2306, Government Code, as added by this Act.
SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
