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	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of a natural disaster housing
3	reconstruction initiative.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to encourage the
6	development of a model reconstruction plan for future
7	reconstruction efforts to increase the effective and efficient
8	delivery of natural disaster recovery services by state agencies.
9	This Act is not meant to affect ongoing reconstruction efforts.
10	SECTION 2. Chapter 418, Government Code, is amended by
11	adding Subchapter J to read as follows:
12	SUBCHAPTER J. NATURAL DISASTER HOUSING RECONSTRUCTION INITIATIVE
13	Sec. 418.301. NATURAL DISASTER HOUSING RECONSTRUCTION
14	ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (a) The natural disaster housing
15	reconstruction advisory committee is composed of:
16	(1) the executive director of the Texas Department of
17	Housing and Community Affairs;
18	(2) the executive director of the Office of Rural
19	Community Affairs;
20	(3) the director of the division; and
21	(4) one representative of each of the following
22	appointed by the natural disaster housing reconstruction
23	coordinator:
24	(A) the College of Engineering of Texas Tech

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1 <u>University;</u> 2 (B) the community and regional planning program 3 of The University of Texas at Austin; 4 (C) the School of Architecture of Rice 5 University; 6 (D) the School of Social Work of The University 7 of Texas at Austin; 8 (E) the Texas Society of Architects; (F) the Austin Community Design and Development 9 10 Center; (G) the Texas Low Income Housing Information 11 12 Service; 13 (H) the Texas Association of Builders; 14 (I) the Texas Manufactured Housing Association; 15 (J) Gulf Coast Interfaith; 16 (K) the United States Department of Homeland 17 Security; 18 (L) the Federal Emergency Management Agency; 19 (M) the United States Department of Housing and 20 Urban Development; 21 (N) the Community Development Corporation of 22 Brownsville; (O) community development corporations from two 23 24 other communities affected by hurricanes; and 25 (P) Habitat for Humanity. 26 (b) The advisory committee shall develop a natural disaster reconstruction plan. In developing this plan, the advisory 27

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1	committee shall:
2	(1) evaluate existing systems of providing temporary
3	housing to victims of natural disasters and develop alternative
4	systems to increase efficiency and cost-effectiveness;
5	(2) evaluate existing models for providing permanent
6	replacement housing to victims of natural disasters;
7	(3) design alternatives to existing models to improve
8	the sustainability, affordability, desirability, and quality of
9	housing rebuilt in the event of future natural disasters;
10	(4) evaluate economic circumstances of elderly,
11	disabled, and low-income victims of natural disasters and develop
12	models for providing affordable replacement housing;
13	(5) recommend programs for the rapid and efficient
14	large-scale production of temporary and permanent replacement
15	housing following a natural disaster; and
16	(6) encourage the participation, coordination, and
17	involvement of appropriate federal organizations.
18	(c) The Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs
19	shall provide funding for the advisory committee through the
20	department's research funds.
21	(d) Chapter 2110 does not apply to the advisory committee.
22	Sec. 418.302. NATURAL DISASTER HOUSING RECONSTRUCTION
23	COORDINATOR. (a) The governor shall appoint an employee of the
24	office of the governor or the administrative head of a state agency
25	as the natural disaster housing reconstruction coordinator. The
26	coordinator serves at the pleasure of the governor.
27	(b) The coordinator shall:

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1	(1) call meetings of the advisory committee as
2	necessary;
3	(2) assist the advisory committee in developing and
4	implementing the natural disaster reconstruction plan;
5	(3) submit the natural disaster reconstruction plan to
6	the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of
7	representatives, and members of the legislature;
8	(4) work with appropriate state agencies to address
9	any housing-related issues, including liens, identified by the
10	advisory committee that may assist state agencies in efforts to
11	reconstruct homes following disasters; and
12	(5) encourage the participation, coordination, and
13	involvement of appropriate federal organizations.
14	(c) The agency that employs the coordinator shall provide
15	funding for the coordinator position using money from any source
16	that may be used to respond to a natural disaster.
17	Sec. 418.303. HOUSING RECONSTRUCTION DEMONSTRATION
18	PROGRAM. (a) Using the natural disaster reconstruction plan
19	developed under this subchapter, the coordinator and advisory
20	committee shall develop and implement a housing reconstruction
21	demonstration program in three areas previously affected by a
22	natural disaster. The program must provide for the replacement of
23	at least 20 houses in each area to test the feasibility of
24	implementing the plan in the production of replacement housing for
25	victims of natural disasters.
26	(b) The program shall be implemented using available funds
27	from the housing trust fund or any other federal or state funds

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Sec. 418.304. ASSISTANCE AND STAFFING. The division, with
the assistance of the Texas Department of Housing and Community
Affairs and the Office of Rural Community Affairs, shall assist the
coordinator and advisory committee as necessary, including by
providing appropriate staff.

7 SECTION 3. (a) Not later than October 1, 2009, the governor 8 shall appoint the natural disaster housing reconstruction 9 coordinator under Section 418.302, Government Code, as added by 10 this Act.

(b) The natural disaster housing reconstruction coordinator shall, not later than 14 days after appointment, call an initial meeting of the advisory committee under Section 418.301, Government Code, as added by this Act.

15 (c) Not later than 60 days after appointment of the 16 coordinator, the advisory committee shall develop a preliminary 17 natural disaster reconstruction plan under Section 418.301(b), 18 Government Code, as added by this Act.

(d) Not later than December 1, 2009, the advisory committeeshall submit the final natural disaster reconstruction plan.

(e) Not later than February 1, 2010, the advisory committee shall implement the housing reconstruction demonstration program established under Section 418.303, Government Code, as added by this Act.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
