## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the amount of hazardous duty pay for certain employees
- 3 of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (h), Section 659.305, Government
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (h) The amount of hazardous duty pay for a particular month
- 8 for a full-time <u>state employee</u> [<del>correctional officer</del>] employed by
- 9 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice is [the lesser of:
- 10 [(1)] \$12 for each 12-month period of lifetime service
- 11 credit accrued by the employee[; or
- 12  $\left[\frac{(2)}{300}\right]$ .
- SECTION 2. This Act does not make an appropriation. A
- 14 provision in this Act that creates a new governmental program,
- 15 creates a new entitlement, or imposes a new duty on a governmental
- 16 entity is not mandatory during a fiscal period for which the
- 17 legislature has not made a specific appropriation to implement the
- 18 provision.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
