1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the amount of hazardous duty pay for certain employees  
1-11 of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subsection (h), Section 659.305, Government  
1-14 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-15 (h) The amount of hazardous duty pay for a particular month  
1-16 for a full-time state employee [~~correctional officer~~] employed by  
1-17 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice is [~~the lesser of:~~

1-18 [~~(1)~~] \$12 for each 12-month period of lifetime service  
1-19 credit accrued by the employee [~~+~~ ~~or~~

1-20 [~~(2)~~ ~~\$300~~].

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act does not make an appropriation. A  
1-22 provision in this Act that creates a new governmental program,  
1-23 creates a new entitlement, or imposes a new duty on a governmental  
1-24 entity is not mandatory during a fiscal period for which the  
1-25 legislature has not made a specific appropriation to implement the  
1-26 provision.

1-27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
