SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2009, the Texas Board of Criminal Justice shall establish a professional standards and labor oversight committee as required by Subsection (a), Section 492.017, Government Code, as added by this Act. Not later than December 1, 2010, the committee shall submit to the governor and the legislature the first report required by Subsection (b), Section 492.017, Government Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
