A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the creation of the water plan projects fund to assist
3	the Texas Water Development Board in the funding of certain
4	projects identified in the state and regional water plans.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 15, Water Code, is amended by adding
7	Subchapter G to read as follows:
8	SUBCHAPTER G. WATER PLAN PROJECTS FUND
9	Sec. 15.431. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
10	(1) "Bond enhancement agreement" has the meaning
11	assigned by Section 17.954.
12	(2) "Debt service" means the payment of principal and
13	interest on bonds issued by the board for water projects described
14	by Section 15.432(c).
15	Sec. 15.432. WATER PLAN PROJECTS FUND. (a) The water plan
16	projects fund is an account within the water infrastructure fund
17	and consists of fees dedicated to the water plan projects fund by
18	the legislature.
19	(b) The board shall use the water plan projects fund as a
20	source of revenue:
21	(1) for debt service related to the funding of water
22	projects described by Subsection (c); and
23	(2) to meet obligations incurred under a bond

enhancement agreement in connection with water projects described

- 2 (c) The board may use the water plan projects fund as
- 3 provided by this section for projects authorized under:
- 4 (1) Subchapter Q;
- 5 (2) Subchapter E, Chapter 16; and
- 6 (3) Subchapter K, Chapter 17.
- 7 Sec. 15.433. TRANSFER TO TEXAS WATER DEVELOPMENT FUND II.
- 8 The comptroller shall transfer from the water plan projects fund to
- 9 the Texas Water Development Fund II money that is to be used for a
- 10 purpose described by Section 15.432(b) related to a project
- 11 <u>authorized under:</u>
- 12 (1) Subchapter E, Chapter 16, in which case the money
- 13 shall be deposited into the state participation account under
- 14 Section 17.957; and
- 15 (2) Subchapter K, Chapter 17, in which case the money
- 16 shall be deposited into the economically distressed areas program
- 17 account under Section 17.958.
- 18 Sec. 15.434. RULES. The board shall adopt rules providing
- 19 for the use of the water plan projects fund consistent with this
- 20 subchapter.
- 21 SECTION 2. Subsection (b), Section 17.957, Water Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- 23 (b) The state participation account is composed of:
- 24 (1) money and assets attributable to water financial
- 25 assistance bonds designated by the board as issued for projects
- 26 described in Section 16.131;
- 27 (2) money from the sale, transfer, or lease of a

- 1 project described in Subdivision (1) that was acquired,
- 2 constructed, reconstructed, developed, or enlarged with money from
- 3 the state participation account;
- 4 (3) payments received under a bond enhancement
- 5 agreement with respect to water financial assistance bonds
- 6 designated by the board as issued for projects described in Section
- 7 16.131;
- 8 (4) investment income earned on money on deposit in
- 9 the state participation account; [and]
- 10 (5) money transferred from the water plan projects
- 11 fund under Subchapter G, Chapter 15; and
- 12 (6) any other funds, regardless of their source, that
- 13 the board directs be deposited to the credit of the state
- 14 participation account.
- 15 SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 17.958, Water Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (b) The economically distressed areas program account is
- 18 composed of:
- 19 (1) money and assets attributable to water financial
- 20 assistance bonds designated by the board as issued for projects
- 21 described in Subchapter K;
- 22 (2) money provided by the federal government, the
- 23 state, political subdivisions, and private entities for the purpose
- 24 of paying debt service on water financial assistance bonds issued
- 25 for purposes provided by Subchapter K;
- 26 (3) payments received under a bond enhancement
- 27 agreement with respect to water financial assistance bonds

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- 1 designated by the board as issued for purposes provided by
- 2 Subchapter K;
- 3 (4) investment income earned on money on deposit in
- 4 the economically distressed areas program account; [and]
- 5 (5) money transferred from the water plan projects
- 6 <u>fund under Subchapter G, Chapter 15; and</u>
- 7 (6) any other funds, regardless of their source, that
- 8 the board directs be deposited to the credit of the economically
- 9 distressed areas program account.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
