- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (e), Section 26.0291, Water Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The commission by rule shall adopt a fee schedule for
- 8 determining the amount of the fee to be charged. The amount of the
- 9 fee may not exceed \$200,000 [\$75,000] for each permit or contract.
- 10 The maximum annual fee under this section for a wastewater
- 11 discharge or waste treatment facility that holds a water right for
- 12 the use of water by the facility may not exceed \$200,000 [$\frac{$75,000}{}$].
- 13 In determining the amount of a fee under this section, the
- 14 commission may consider:
- 15 (1) waste discharge permitting factors such as flow
- 16 volume, toxic pollutant potential, level of traditional pollutant,
- 17 and heat load;
- 18 (2) the designated uses and segment ranking
- 19 classification of the water affected by discharges from the
- 20 permitted facility;
- 21 (3) the expenses necessary to obtain and administer
- 22 the NPDES program;
- 23 (4) the reasonable costs of administering the water
- 24 quality management programs under Section 26.0135; and

- 1 (5) any other reasonable costs necessary to administer
- 2 and enforce a water resource management program reasonably related
- 3 to the activities of the persons required to pay a fee under this
- 4 section.
- 5 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 6 fees due on or after September 1, 2009. The assessment and
- 7 collection of fees due before the effective date of this Act is
- 8 governed by the former law, and that law is continued in effect for
- 9 that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
