- 2 relating to the authority of a groundwater conservation district to
- 3 assess production fees.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 36.205, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 36.205. AUTHORITY TO SET FEES. (a) A district may set
- 8 fees for administrative acts of the district, such as filing
- 9 applications. Fees set by a district may not unreasonably exceed
- 10 the cost to the district of performing the administrative function
- 11 for which the fee is charged.
- 12 (b) A district shall set and collect fees for all services
- 13 provided outside the boundaries of the district. The fees may not
- 14 unreasonably exceed the cost to the district of providing the
- 15 services outside the district.
- 16 (c) A district may assess production fees based on the
- 17 amount of water authorized by permit to be withdrawn from a well or
- 18 the amount actually withdrawn. A district may assess the fees in
- 19 lieu of, or in conjunction with, any taxes otherwise levied by the
- 20 district. A district may use revenues generated by the fees for any
- 21 lawful purpose. Production fees shall not exceed:
- 22 (1) \$1 per acre-foot payable annually for water used
- 23 for agricultural use; or
- 24 (2) 30 cents $\begin{bmatrix} \$10 \end{bmatrix}$ per 1,000 gallons $\begin{bmatrix} acre-foot \end{bmatrix}$

- 1 payable annually for water used for any other purpose.
- 2 (d) [The Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District and
- 3 the Guadalupe County Groundwater Conservation District may not
- 4 charge production fees for an annual period greater than \$1 per
- 5 acre-foot for water used for agricultural use or 17 cents per
- 6 thousand gallons for water used for any other purpose. This
- 7 subsection shall take precedence over all prior enactments.
- 8 [(e)] Subsection (c) does not apply to the following
- 9 districts:

- (1) the Edwards Aquifer Authority;
- 11 (2) the Fort Bend Subsidence District;
- 12 (3) the Harris-Galveston Coastal Subsidence District;
- 13 (4) the Barton Springs Edwards Aguifer Conservation
- 14 District; or
- 15 (5) any district that collects a property tax and that
- 16 was created before September 1, 1999, unless otherwise authorized
- 17 by special law.
- 18 (e) [(f)] A district[, including a district described under
- 19 Subsection $(d)_{r}$] may assess a production fee under Subsection (c)
- 20 for any water produced under an exemption under Section 36.117 if
- 21 that water is subsequently sold to another person.
- (f) (g) A district may assess a transportation fee under
- 23 Section 36.122.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
