- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 3.202, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 7 Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(e) For purposes of this section, all retirement</u>
- 9 <u>allowances</u>, annuities, accumulated contributions, optional
- 10 benefits, and money in the various public retirement system
- 11 accounts of this state that are community property subject to the
- 12 participating spouse's sole management, control, and disposition
- 13 are not subject to any claim for payment of a criminal restitution
- 14 judgment entered against the nonparticipant spouse except to the
- 15 extent of the nonparticipant spouse's interest as determined in a
- 16 qualified domestic relations order under Chapter 804, Government
- 17 <u>Code.</u>
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a claim for payment of a
- 19 criminal restitution judgment issued on or after the effective date
- 20 of this Act. A claim for payment of a criminal restitution judgment
- 21 issued before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 22 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 23 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
