- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by 5
- amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsection (c-1) to 6
- 7 read as follows:

- (c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a classroom teacher, 19
- full-time librarian, full-time counselor certified under 20
- 21 Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse is entitled to a monthly
- salary that is at least equal to the sum of: 22

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- 23 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have
- 24 received for the current school year under the district's salary

- 1 schedule for the 2008-2009 school year, if that schedule had been in
- 2 <u>effect for the current school year, including any local supplement</u>
- 3 and any money representing a career ladder supplement the employee
- 4 would have received in the current school year; and
- 5 (2) the following applicable amount, depending on the
- 6 employee's years of experience:
- 7 (A) \$200, if the employee has less than six years
- 8 of experience;
- 9 (B) \$300, if the employee has at least six but
- 10 <u>less than 11 years of experience;</u>
- 11 (C) \$400, if the employee has at least 11 but less
- 12 than 16 years of experience; or
- 13 (D) \$500, if the employee has at least 16 years of
- 14 experience.
- 15 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
- 16 counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse
- 17 employed by a school district in the 2009-2010 [2006-2007] school
- 18 year is, as long as the employee is employed by the same district,
- 19 entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the
- 20 employee received for the 2009-2010 [$\frac{2006-2007}{2000}$] school year.
- SECTION 2. Section 42.2516, Education Code, is amended by
- 22 adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 23 (e-1) The amount of state aid or credit to which a school
- 24 district is entitled under Section 42.2518 is in addition to the
- 25 amount of revenue to which the district is entitled under
- 26 Subsection (b).
- 27 SECTION 3. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is

- 1 amended by adding Section 42.2518 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 42.2518. ADDITIONAL STATE AID OR CREDIT AGAINST COST
- 3 OF ATTENDANCE CREDITS FOR PROFESSIONAL STAFF SALARIES. (a) A
- 4 school district, including a school district that is otherwise
- 5 ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled to state
- 6 aid in an amount, as determined by the commissioner, equal to the
- 7 sum of the following amounts, as determined by the number of
- 8 classroom teachers, full-time librarians, full-time counselors
- 9 <u>certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time school</u>
- 10 nurses employed by the district and entitled to a minimum salary
- 11 under Section 21.402:
- 12 (1) \$2,000 multiplied by the number of eligible
- 13 employees with less than six years of experience;
- 14 (2) \$3,000 multiplied by the number of eligible
- 15 employees with at least six but less than 11 years of experience;
- 16 (3) \$4,000 multiplied by the number of eligible
- 17 employees with at least 11 but less than 16 years of experience; and
- 18 (4) \$5,000 multiplied by the number of eligible
- 19 employees with at least 16 years of experience.
- 20 (b) A school district that is required to take action under
- 21 Chapter 41 to reduce its wealth per student to the equalized wealth
- 22 level is entitled to a credit, in the amount of state aid to which
- 23 the district is entitled under this section, against the total
- 24 amount required under Section 41.093 for the district to purchase
- 25 attendance credits.
- 26 (c) A determination by the commissioner under this section
- 27 is final and may not be appealed.

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- 1 (d) The commissioner may adopt rules to implement this
- 2 <u>section</u>.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
