A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

Texas A&M University-College Station, and to authorizing the

- 2 relating to limiting increases in a student health services fee at
- 4 financing, construction, maintenance and improvement of health
- 5 facilities with a student health services fee at a component
- 6 institution of the Texas A&M University System.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 54.507, Education Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:

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- 10 Sec. 54.507. GROUP HOSPITAL AND MEDICAL SERVICES FEES;
- 11 STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES FEE; TEXAS A & M UNIVERSITY SYSTEM.
- 12 (a) The Board of Regents of The Texas A & M University System may
- 13 levy and collect from each student at any institution of higher
- 14 education which is a part of The Texas A & M University System a
- 15 compulsory group hospital and medical services fee student health
- 16 services fee not to exceed \$75 for each regular semester and not to
- 17 exceed $$\frac{25}{}$ 37.50 for each term of each summer session. The
- 18 compulsory group hospital and medical services fee student health
- 19 <u>services fee</u> may not be levied unless the levy of the fee has been
- 20 approved by a majority vote of those students at the affected
- 21 institution participating in a general student election called for
- 22 that purpose.
- 23 (b) In addition to the fee authorized under Subsection (a)
- 24 of this section, the Board of Regents of The Texas A & M University

- 1 System may levy and collect from each student registered at Prairie
- 2 View A & M University a supplemental group hospital and medical
- 3 services fee not to exceed \$30 for each regular semester and not to
- 4 exceed \$12.50 for each term of the summer session. The supplemental
- 5 group hospital and medical services fee may not be levied unless the
- 6 levy of the fee has been approved by a majority vote of the students
- 7 registered at Prairie View A & M University participating in a
- 8 general election called for that purpose.
- 9 <u>(c) At Texas A&M University-College Station the fee shall</u>
- 10 not exceed \$125 for each regular semester and is not to exceed
- 11 \$62.50 for each term of each summer session. The fee may not be
- 12 increased to an amount that exceeds 10 percent or more of the total
- 13 amount of the fee that is in effect on September 1, 2009, or as last
- 14 approved by a student vote under this subsection unless the
- 15 increase has been approved by a majority vote of the students
- 16 participating in a general election called for that purpose or a
- 17 <u>majority vote of the Student Government.</u>
- 18 <u>(d)</u> A fee levied under this section at a component
- 19 institution of The Texas A & M University System may be used only to
- 20 provide hospital or other medical services to students registered
- 21 at that component institution and for financing, constructing,
- 22 maintaining, and improving new and existing health facilities.
- 23 <u>(e)</u> If, in an academic year, the total compulsory fee
- 24 charged under this section is more than 10 percent higher than the
- 25 compulsory fee charged under this section for the previous academic
- 26 year, the increase does not take effect unless the increase is
- 27 approved by a majority vote of the students voting in an election

- 1 held for that purpose.
- 2 <u>(f)</u> If, in an academic year, the total compulsory fee
- 3 charged under this section is proposed to be increased by an amount
- 4 less than 10 percent over that charged in the previous academic
- 5 year, the Board of Regents of The Texas A & M University System may,
- 6 in lieu of an election, hold a public meeting on the increase prior
- 7 to its taking effect in which students have the opportunity to
- 8 comment.
- 9 (g) An election under this section must also permit the
- 10 students to vote on whether hospital and medical services should be
- 11 provided to students at the institution by the institution or by a
- 12 private entity. The vote by the students on the responsibility for
- 13 provision of hospital and medical services to students at the
- 14 institution is not binding on the institution.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on September 1, 2009.
