- 5 SECTION 1. Section 29.005, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) Unless otherwise provided by federal law, a member of
- 8 the committee established under Subsection (a) or any other person
- 9 associated with the committee is not entitled to have an attorney
- 10 present at a committee meeting.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 29.006, Education Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 29.006. CONTINUING ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (a) The
- 14 governor shall appoint a continuing advisory committee, composed of
- 15 17 members, under 20 U.S.C. Section 1412(a)(21). The appointments
- 16 are not subject to confirmation by the senate. Members of the
- 17 committee are appointed for staggered terms of four years with the
- 18 terms of eight or nine members expiring on February 1 of each
- 19 odd-numbered year.
- 20 (b) The agency shall promptly provide the continuing
- 21 advisory committee with a copy of each written decision resulting
- 22 from a special education due process hearing conducted by or on

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
