## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the award of attorney's fees to a property owner who 3 prevails in a property tax appeal. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 42.29(a), Tax Code, is amended 5 as follows: 6 Sec. 42.29. ATTORNEY'S FEES. (a) A property owner who 7 prevails in an appeal to the court under [Section] Sections 8 25.25(c) or (d), 42.25 or 42.26 may be awarded reasonable 9 attorney's fees. The amount of the award may not exceed the greater 10 of: 11 (1)\$15,000; or 12 13 (2) 20 percent of the total amount by which the 14 property owner's tax liability is reduced as a result of the appeal. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 19
