- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1.111, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 7 (j) Any individual exempt under Section 1152.002 of the
- 8 Texas Occupations Code from registration as a property tax
- 9 consultant or a senior property tax consultant, that files a
- 10 protest on behalf of a property owner, shall be entitled to all
- 11 notices from the appraisal district regarding the property or
- 12 properties subject to that protest until revoked by the individual
- 13 or the property owner.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
