A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to an annual report by the Border Security Council
3	regarding criminal street gangs and expanding gang prevention
4	efforts.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 421.0025, Government Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
8	(g) The Border Security Council shall submit to the governor
9	a report regarding criminal street gangs and expanding gang
10	prevention efforts. The report must be approved by a majority of
11	the council members and must include:
12	(1) an evaluation of the threat that criminal street
13	gangs and gang-related crime pose to the infrastructure and
14	well-being of the state, each county, and each municipality with a
15	population of more than 100,000; and
16	(2) recommendations on actions that may be taken to:
17	(A) prevent recruitment of youth into gangs by:
18	(i) identifying best practices across the
19	United States utilized to combat criminal street gangs and
20	gang-related crime; and
21	(ii) identifying factors within each
22	municipality with a population of more than 100,000 that may make
23	youth susceptible to gang recruitment;
24	(B) identify local community-based organizations

- 1 across the state willing to participate in a collaborative effort
- 2 <u>so as to:</u>
- 3 (i) assess the organization's current
- 4 resources; and
- 5 (ii) assess the organization's best
- 6 practices in conjunction with local law enforcement gang prevention
- 7 efforts; and
- 8 (C) identify strategies to include youth,
- 9 families, and community-based organizations in the decision-making
- 10 process so as to:
- 11 <u>(i) increase interaction and communication</u>
- 12 between all stakeholders;
- 13 (ii) establish trust between all
- 14 stakeholders; and
- 15 <u>(iii)</u> secure support from all stakeholders.
- 16 SECTION 2. The Border Security Council shall submit the
- 17 first annual report regarding criminal street gangs and expanding
- 18 gang prevention efforts to the governor as required by Subsection
- 19 (g), Section 421.0025, Government Code, as added by this Act, not
- 20 later than September 1, 2010.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
